## RE: Outdoor Visits with Park Place residents in Ontario

Dear Ontario Park Place Residents and Family Members:

As of June 18, 2020, the Ontario government in consultation with the Chief Medical Officer of Health has decided to allow long-term care homes to permit outdoor visits of one person per resident each week at a minimum. Physical distancing will be required for all visits. This approach will ensure the health and safety of residents, staff and visitors.

Park Place's Quality Team has worked diligently with site leaders to create the safest guidelines.

At this time, indoor visits in long term care are still not permitted. As soon as there are any changes or updates to visitation restrictions, we will notify families.
