Indoor and Outdoor Visitation in AB

Dear AB Park Place Residents and Family Members:

On July 16, the Alberta Provincial Health Officer, Dr. Deena Hinshaw, updated the restrictions on visitors at long-term care and supportive living facilities in Alberta. As per the most recent order, indoor visits with up to two designated family members/support persons may begin across the province.
