- Daily rounds of the Home, completing preventative maintenance schedule and searching and monitoring for any plant concerns and/or potential issues.
- In winter – ensures sidewalks, patios, and all exit areas are clear of ice and snow.
- Prioritizes items needing attention and fixing.
- Repairs equipment/plant as able and necessary; refers to appropriate outside contractors as required for equipment and plant maintenance and /or repair and assists as necessary.
- Puts away supplies as delivered.
- Assists residents with moving of furniture when required.
- 15. Checks safety of resident equipment upon move-in (eg. CSA approved electrical equipment such as radios, shavers).
- 16. Ensures all rooms are inspected and free of mechanical hazards, prior to a resident moving in.
- Investigates all accidents.
- Ensures proper maintenance of equipment.
- Responsible to take every reasonable precaution to protect the safety of residents, self, other workers and the general public.
- Reports any near miss, injury, and accident or equipment damage to Site Leader immediately and completes required reports.
- Corrects and/or reports unsafe conditions and sets a good example.

The qualification required include;

- High School graduate;
- Building maintenance and/or relevant experience
- Ability to communicate effectively and organize work.
- Care for seniors
- Physical ability to carry out the duties of the position.
