We are looking for highly motivated, organized individuals who are seeking an opportunity to contribute to the senior community!

We currently have a housekeeper / laundry aide position at one of our beautiful long term care facilities, Sunridge care Home.

Responsibilities:

- Cleans areas such as floors, stairways, walls, windows, and walkways by methods such as sweeping, spot washing and damp / wet mopping, scrubbing, stripping, sealing, waxing, and polishing.
- Cleans carpets and rugs by methods such as vacuuming, shampooing, brushing, and using appropriate equipment
- Cleans items such as furniture, woodwork, ledges, fixtures, and blinds/curtains by methods such as dusting, polishing, washing, and wiping.
- Cleans and sanitizes washrooms and replenishes items such as soap and towels.
- Maintains cleanliness and organization of Resident rooms and washrooms.
- Checks and restocks housekeeping supplies to predetermined levels.
- Maintains related equipment by cleaning, lubricating, and replacing items such as filter bags and belts.
- Performs other related duties as assigned.

Qualifications and Skill:

- Grade 10 or an equivalent combination of education, training, and experience.
- WHIMS certificate.
- Previous experience in long-term care (preferred).

To mitigate the risk COVID-19 transmission among persons in our care, patients, residents and staff, an order under the Public Health Act was enacted to limit movement of staff between long-term care facilities.

While this order is in place, staff are limited to working in only one (1) private long-term care hospital (facility), licensed long-term care facility, registered assisted living facility, stand-alone extended care hospital, or provincial mental health facility.

The successful applicant for this job posting must provide satisfactory proof, or have such proof on file, that they have received the COVID-19 vaccination and any required COVID-19 booster vaccination. This requirement shall be waived if the applicant has not received the vaccination due to any legislated protected human rights grounds. In such a case, and upon presentation of sufficient proof, the CareCorp Seniors Services shall make reasonable attempts to accommodate the applicant to carry out their role where possible recognizing that the health and safety of other employees and residents will be a priority.
