- Assessing and implementing individual resident goal-based programs to assist residents to regain and/or maintain an optimal level of independence.
- Assess for equipment and mobility needs (ambulation, aides, transfers, toileting, bed mobility)
- Assess for falls and pain risk and make recommendations to prevent
- Assess and make applications for AADL equipment such as seating and cushioning to ensure skin and musculoskeletal integrity, prevent falls, provide comfort, reduce agitation, and support breathing.
- Provide recommendations for therapy programs for each resident.
- Work collaboratively with the interdisciplinary team to support the PPSL Care Model and residents' choice.

Qualifications include:

- Graduate of an approved school of occupational therapy. Two (2) years recent related experience, preferably as an occupational therapist working with the elderly.
- Current practicing registration with the applicable provincial registering body. Experience in a senior's care environment.
- An AADL approved authorizer
