This includes U-First training, an innovative program that helps caregivers better understand and prevent behaviors associated with dementia. Our first group of care aides has already begun this valuable education. This work complements our current antipsychotic reduction initiative as we explore more personcentered, non-medication approaches to managing behaviors.

In clinical care, our nursing team has just completed WCAT training, the second phase of Fraser Health's Wound Care initiative, further strengthening our commitment to highquality, holistic care.
