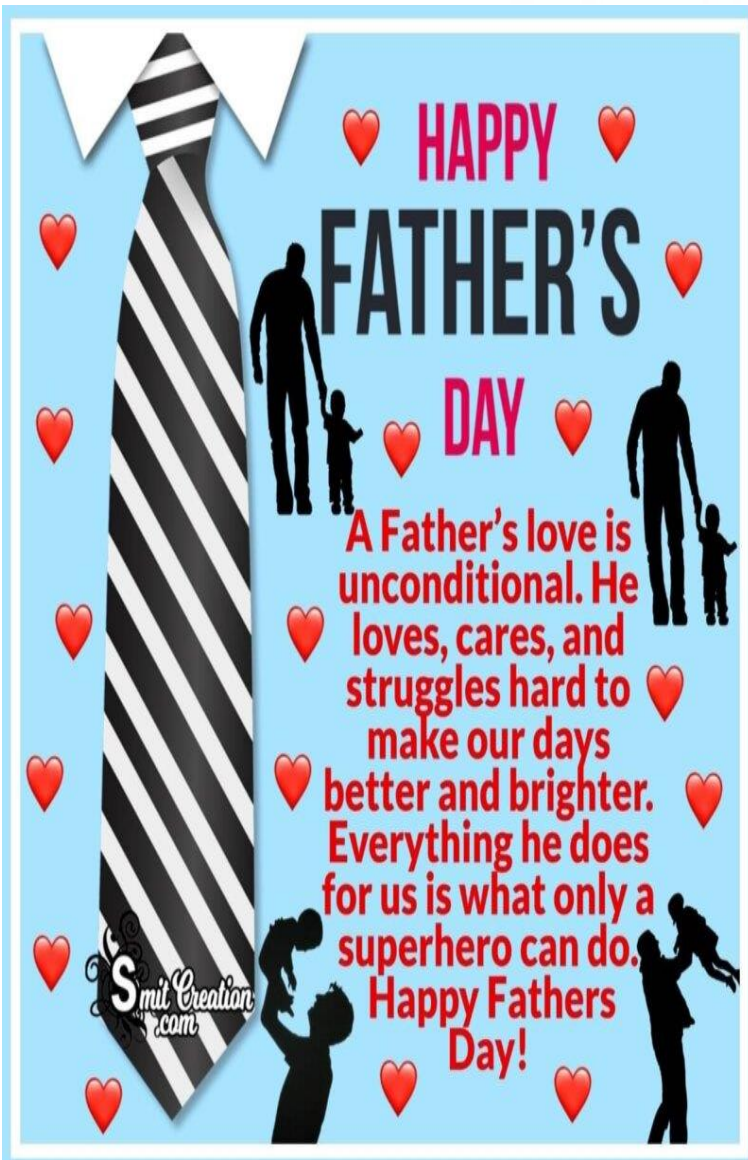
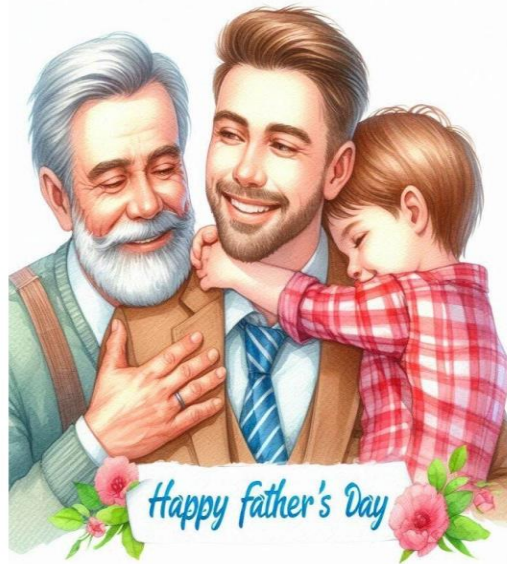

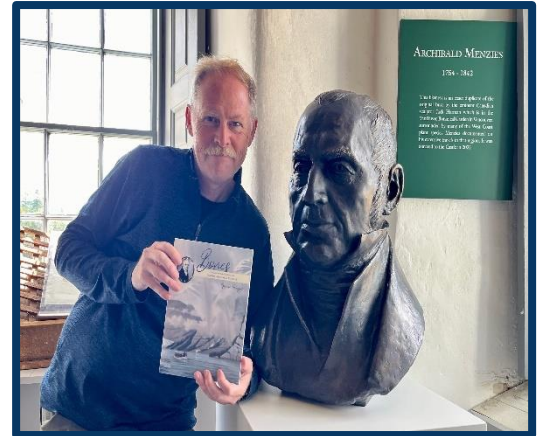
Garden Club
